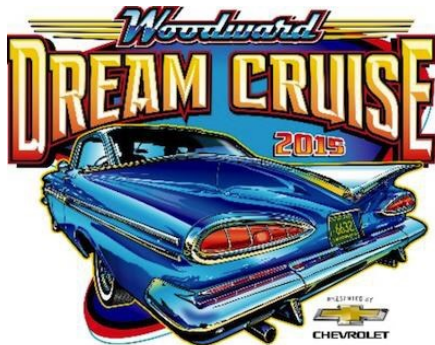
CEMA Car Show
